



15 years ago, back in 2008, Art-Line, a non-for-profit art support foundation, was created. Since then, it has become noticeable not only on Moscow's cultural footprint but also beyond its borders. The main mission of Art-Line is the popularization of contemporary domestic art; active and intense work is ongoing in various domains such as exhibitions, concerts, publishing and educational activities.

The Foundation's partners include famous cultural heritage sites and truly national treasures of Russia such as the State Russian Museum, State Tretyakov Gallery and Tsaritsyno Museum-Reserve. The exhibitions "Step to Bronze", "Sports in Art", "Children of Our Yard", "Russian Insomnia", "Secrets of the Russian Soul", "Glance from Germany" were visited by many guests and extensively covered by various media and Internet portals. The beautifully published catalogs of these exhibitions were sent to the libraries of educational institutions. The Foundation actively participated in the annual international festival "Imperial Gardens of Russia"; thanks to our initiative, there is now an "Outdoor Rose Museum" in the Mikhailovsky Garden.

In 2011, Art-Line created a children's musical band headed by Tatyana Malysheva, a professional pianist and talented teacher. The main focus area is the popularization of classical music performed by talented young musicians in prestigious concert halls, palaces, community centers, museums and even in the famous Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory.

350 truly gifted young musicians aged between 7 and 18 used to be members of this unique musical band during its active years and now study at the Central Music School of the Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory and Gnessin State Musical College with many of them having become the best students of Russian music schools: performers of classical and modern works playing piano, violin, cello, harp, clarinet, bassoon, flute, xylophone, marimba, oboe, button accordion, harp and balalaika. Young musicians perform in duets, trios and quartets. All of them are prize winners of

prestigious music competitions and many of them are scholarship holders of “Art-Line” Art Support Foundation.

The band takes an active part in the long-term educational program “Children Help Children”. The participants of the charity concerts were applauded in Moscow, Kazan and abroad. The money raised from the performances were remitted to the Children’s Republican Hospital in Moscow, Angela Vavilova hospice in Kazan and a boarding school for visually impaired children in Vyazma.

The assets of the Foundation’s musical band include breathtaking concert programs shown at the State Historical Museum, Ostrovsky State Museum-Humanitarian Center “Preodoljenje”, Scriabin Memorial Museum, State Russian Museum (Saint Petersburg) on a subscription basis and within the “Music in Russian Estates” series and memorable musical and poetic programs “Russian Holidays” hosted by many

cities of Russia. Since the Foundation’s creation, successful musical performances have taken place in Germany, France, Monaco, Poland, Denmark, Italy and Finland.

The activities of “Art-Line” Art Support Foundation have been honored with commendations issued by the Presidential Executive Office of the Russian Federation, State Historical Museum and Board of the Charitable Foundation for Helping Children with Leukemia named after Angela Vavilova, Republic of Tatarstan. The President of the Foundation was awarded “PROFILO DONNA”, a prestigious international award of the Italian Republic, and the national award “FASHION OLYMP” in the “Art Charity” category.

For the fifth year in a row, the creative team of “Art-Line” Art Support Foundation has been holding a series of concert programs, “Constellation of Young Talents to Honored Veterans of the Homeland”, with unflinching success. They feature unforgettable melodies of the songs of the war years and timeless classical music liked by the hoar headed veterans of the Great Patriotic War.

In 2020, during the pandemic, when concerts were banned, 23 editions of Art- Line’s “Musical and Poetic Windows” were prepared and posted on YouTube for the wide public that generated a huge number of views – after all, they featured the most profound poetic lines by our best poets.

In 2020-2022, the “Falling in Love with the Classics Since Childhood, Moscow Children’s Assembly” project was successfully implemented and won the Moscow Mayor’s Grants Competition three times.

The “Four Seasons” series subscription program offering access to the evenings of music and poetry that has its loyal audience has been implemented for several years together with Literaturnaya Gazeta, the oldest Russian culturological periodical, and the Central House of Writers.

In 2021, Arbat Reading Hall opened its doors to visitors on the initiative of the President of the Foundation. 10 meetings have been held since then with its regular visitors immersing themselves in the atmosphere of the reading hall and getting acquainted with modern writers and learning loads of interesting things about contemporary literature and new views on historical figures. From the very beginning, direct conversation with the authors of popular books, Q&A sessions and an indispensable autograph signing session have become an integral part of Arbat Reading Hall’s meetings. There was also an off-site meeting in Saint Petersburg visited by the members of the reading hall in the year of the anniversary of Peter the Great to meet Yakov Gordin, a famous writer and historian.

During the 2021/2022 season, the Foundation organized and successfully held “Poet and Music”, the first international music and poetry festival, commemorating the anniversary of Musa Jalil, a legendary poet-hero of the Great Patriotic War, Hero of

the Soviet Union and winner of the Lenin Prize. The concerts within the “Poet and Music” festival were hosted by the concert halls of Naberezhnye Chelny, Nizhnekamsk, Almetyevsk, Jalil, Kazan and Moscow to become remarkable events in their cultural life.

During the 2022/2023 season, the “Poet and Music” international music and poetry festival will be held for the second time. The young musicians’ performances are looked forward to in the cities of Tatarstan such as Kazan, Bugulma, Naberezhnye Chelny, Nizhnekamsk, Almetyevsk. The festival will end with two gala concerts that will mark the birthday of the author of the Moabit Notebooks. The first of them featuring the winners of the festival will be held on February 19, 2023 in Kazan in the Salikh Saydashev Concert Hall. And the festival’s highlights will be enjoyed by the audience who will come to the capital’s Zaryadye Hall on February 25, 2023. It will

feature the winners of the festival and prominent professional musicians and performing artists.

Art-Line's emblem has been depicted on new book releases for several years. The Art Support Foundation has developed a program for publishing works in various fields ranging from painting to cultural essays. The books published by EKSMO and "U Nikitskikh Vorot" publishing houses were highly appreciated by both critics and readers.
